



The Neighbourhood Plan and Neighbourhood Development Order Steering Groups would like to thank all those who have responded to the Initial Parish Consultation on the Burcot and Clifton Hampden Neighbourhood Plan and development proposals.

About 70 households responded to the consultation, mostly from Clifton Hampden and some from Burcot. A significant majority expressed support for the Neighbourhood Plan as drafted and the proposals for a new surgery, housing, additional parking and other infrastructure improvements, and the benefits they will bring to the Parish. On this basis the Steering Groups will continue to take the project forward.

In your responses you have made a wide range of points and comments and raised questions. After a break for Christmas and the New Year, we will be analysing the responses in great detail in order to have a full understanding of what you have told us.

We will report our findings back to you in late January, and hold further dialogue particularly with those of you who have expressed concerns about how the proposals could impact you. We will attempt to address, reassure and resolve as many questions as we can through a fuller explanation of the rationale behind the proposals and the process by which they were developed, and we will consider amendments to the design to reduce the impact on those particularly affected.
