62	<b>Minutes</b> The Minutes of the meeting of the meeting of 16 <sup>th</sup> October 2019 were agreed as drawn.

64	<b>Recreation Ground Committee</b>  It was reported that treatment has taken place on the tennis courts to remove moss. Further work will be required in the spring to fill holes and paint lines on the courts, and the cost of this work will be £250. The Parish Council agreed a final payment of £125 for the upkeep of the tennis courts this year.  The Parish Council noted that there was an increase in dog fouling the recreation ground. Dogs are not currently permitted on the ground, although dogs are exceptionally allowed on some social occasions. It was agreed that PH would discuss with the recreation ground committee, and would flyer houses on the Oxford Road.	PH	
65	<b>Village Hall Committee</b>  The Village Hall Committee report noted that the next Coffee morning would take place on Friday. It was reported that the last social club was very busy and there had been good attendance for the rugby. There will be a Christmas event and a cinema night on 13 December.  Issues have been raised with the WIFI in the Village Hall. The Chair asked that these be reported for review.
