OVERWHELMING 90%+ SUPPORT

HOUSING

Please tell us what you think of this draft policy on Site Allocation for Housing, whether you agree with the overall approach and any other points you wish to make.

Strong support 90%+ for principle of more housing, virtually unanimous that should be split between smaller sites. Some concerns and reservations about where housing would be.

Preferences expressed widely for smaller properties affordable for young and/ or for downsizing from larger properties. Also for local residents and keyworkers.

SCHOOL

Strong support for school from all who felt qualified to comment. Many comments that it is an important component to the village remaining a community rather than a dormitory and that it is key to attracting families to village

SURGERY and PHARMACY

Please tell us what you think of this draft policy on the Surgery and Pharmacy, whether you agree with the overall approach and any other points you wish to make. Please include any other medical facilities you might like to see in the village.

Strong support for retention. Some desire to retain on present site. Significant minority expressing village centre/walking distance of centre location.

RECREATION GROUND AND THE VILLAGE HALL

Please tell us what you think of the options for the facilities on the Recreation Ground and the Village Hall, which one you prefer, and any other points you wish to make.

Hopelessly divided. Probable majority for Village Hall as is and rebuild others on rec site.

Consultation with the Village Hall committee revealed a strong preference for the Village Hall to remain a separate entity on its current site. A key reason is that the village hall is manageable for a small volunteer committee who are dedicated to managing it. A community centre would not appeal to a volunteer committee to manage, and would therefore probably require some form of professional management arrangements.

DESIGN

Strong support. Some criticism not specific or detailed enough

GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE

Strong overall support. Support for cycle paths.

THE BOATHOUSE

Very Mixed. About 35/40% in favour. Probably 30% or so opposed. Balance not opposed in principal but worried e.g. re flooding costs and/that it should be for local use only. Some support for boat landing stage.
